Trucks were<br>carrying demountable<br>buildings to Rocglen and<br>nearly ran school bus off the<br>road.  | Whitehaven advised the<br>complainant that the<br>demountables were transferred<br>via a contractor so we had little<br>control over their drivers'<br>behaviour. Complainant was<br>advised there would be few<br>additional deliveries and most new<br>deliveries will be via the haul road<br>when constructed.   | No further follow up required.   |
| Phone call to<br>Whitehaven's<br>Boggabri<br>office      | 20/08/2008<br>8:30am      | Dust from Wean Road from<br>mine settling on the<br>complainant's house.<br>Significant increase in traffic<br>on Wean Road, particularly<br>mine vehicles travelling out to<br>Rocglen. Complainant<br>thought most traffic was<br>supposed to come from the<br>Gunnedah end and not along<br>their section of Wean Road. | Contacted Project Manager and<br>arranged for water cart to water<br>northern section of Wean Road at<br>least until haul route is opened,<br>with specific targeting of the road<br>adjacent to the "Penryn" house.   | Not required. Watering of Wean<br>Road will resolve dust issue.  |
| Phone call to<br>Whitehaven's<br>Gunnedah<br>CHPP office | 21/11/2008<br>~9:00am     | Complainant claimed he had<br>no consultation in regard to<br>placement of air and dust<br>monitors on his property and<br>mine related personnel<br>accessing his property without<br>his knowledge.  | The complainant was contacted by<br>phone and attempts to reason<br>with him failed. The complainant<br>was told several attempts to<br>contact him were made on<br>numerous occasions in regards to<br>the placement of the PM <sub>10</sub> HVAS,<br>including at least 3 phone calls and<br>a letter. A \$50/month<br>compensation proposal was<br>refused and the complainant<br>indicated that he wanted all air<br>monitoring equipment removed. | All air and dust monitoring<br>equipment has since been<br>removed from the property, with<br>the PM <sub>10</sub> HVAS relocated to the<br>Whitehaven owned "Glenroc",<br>immediately north of the mine<br>site.<br>The complainant was contacted<br>prior to Whitehaven personnel<br>accessing his property to remove<br>monitoring equipment. |
