Conditions attached to the approval

1. To offset the impact to the White Box-Yellow Box-Blakely's Red Gum Grassy Woodland and Derived Native Grassland Ecological Community and foraging habitats of the Regent Honeyeater and Swift Parrot the person taking the action must register a legally binding conservation mechanism over the Werris Creek Life of Mine (LOM) Extension Project Biodiversity Offset Strategy (BOS) sites identified in the map at Appendix 1 and an additional area of at least 74 hectares of White Box-Yellow Box Blakely's Red Gum Grassy Woodland and Derived Native Grassland Ecological community (together, the Offset Areas). The mechanism/s must provide enduring projection for the offset area and unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the **Minister** must be registered by 31 December 2018.

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Written notification of registration must be provided to the **Department** within 2 weeks of registration of the offset area.
