² LF is estimated equivalent mining noise (LF = low frequency for band 20-630 HZ)
 • The results are filtered to exclude the influence of excessive wind speed (> 3m/s) and rainfall,
 • Monitoring results may include noise from other sources

Weather Predictions for 03 December 2021
North West Slopes Plains for Friday. Mostly sunny. The chance of fog on the S slopes early this morning. Slight chance of a shower on the S slopes late this afternoon and evening. Near zero chance of rain elsewhere. The chance of a thunderstorm late this afternoon and evening. Light winds becoming S/SW 15 to 20 km/h in the late afternoon then becoming light in the evening. Daytime maximum temperatures 30 to 36.
