North West Slopes Plains for Saturday. Mostly sunny. The chance of fog on the plains early this morning. Slight chance of a shower on the N slopes during the morning and afternoon. Near zero chance of rain elsewhere. The chance of a thunderstorm in the N this afternoon. Light winds becoming W 20 to 30 km/h in the middle of the day then becoming light in the evening.
