Weather Predictions for 20 November 2020
Hot and mostly sunny. Slight chance of a shower on the S plains during this afternoon and early evening. Near zero chance of rain elsewhere. The chance of a thunderstorm during this afternoon and early evening. Winds N/NE 20 to 30 km/h tending N/NW 15 to 25 km/h in the middle of the day then becoming light in the early afternoon. Daytime maximum temperatures 32 to 38.
